Upon arrival, participants should travel to their pre-arranged housing.

Participants are encouraged to take the Go Airport Express shuttle service directly to their prearranged housing. The fare is approximately \$55-75 flat fee for a shared ride shuttle van (typically 2 to 3 Stops) dependent on the total number of passenger(s) in that specific shuttle. This rate includes all taxes and fees from either airport. Participants can purchase tickets before they arrive by making a reservation online at: https://www.airportexpress.com/reservations.

To purchase a ticket after arrival, participants can go to the Baggage Claim area near Ground Transportation at either airport, at the "Go Airport Express" kiosk.
