PLACEMENT INFORMATION

Job Description:

Lifeguards actively guard all pools, activity areas, and slide attractions per Ellis and Associates ILTP license. They must complete and maintain the E&A certification that will be provided by Splish Spalsh Waterpark. Lifeguards are required; to continuously swim in a Front Crawl or Breaststroke (on their stomach facing forward) swim without stopping for 200 yards (183 Meters), tread water for two minutes with hands above the water, and retrieve a 10 pound (4.5 Kilogram)brick from the bottom of a pool that is up to 10 feet (3 Meters) to receive the E&A License. This includes advanced swimming skills while your head is under water. Lifeguards must be able to stand or walk for long periods of time, and be in various depths of water (ranging from ankle deep to chest deep) for 30 minutes to an hour throughout the duration of their shift.

Additional Tasks:

Continuously enforce all Park rules while dispatching and attending all slides and attractions. Providing exceptional guest service including but not limited to provide information and direction to guest as needed Provide a safe and clean facility by effectively managing attractions and grounds Provide In-Water Rescues, CPR, and/or First Aid as needed. Provide assistance in other departments including but not limited to Landscaping.

Additional Qualifications:

Must have a vision of 20/25 or 20/25 corrected vision, and always wear corrective lens or lenses to assure 20/25 vision while on duty. Must have strong communication skills, a friendly, positive attitude, and be dedicated to customer service.

Must be attentive to guests and knowledgeable of the property to assist them.

Must be able to work as a team or individually

Must be flexible and able to work where they are needed.

Must have the ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintaining instructions, and procedure manuals.

Must have the ability to read, write, and speak in English

Must have the ability to understand and respond to verbal instructions.

Must have a friendly, positive attitude and be dedicated to customer service.

Qualifications & Conditions

Swimming

Description:

Lifeguards are required; to continuously swim in a Front Crawl or Breaststroke (on their stomach facing forward) swim without stopping for 200 yards (183 Meters), tread water for two minutes with hands above the water, and retrieve a 10 pound (4.5 Kilogram)brick from the bottom of a pool that is up to 10 feet (3 Meters). Lifeguards must be in various depths of water (ranging from ankle deep to chest deep) for 30 minutes to an hour throughout the duration of their shift.

Description:

Lifeguards must be willing to work both in water, regardless of weather and/or temperature as well as out of water in direct sunlight for a range of 30 - 60 minutes in a single area. There are rotations that happen so that you move and are in multiple areas per day.

Uniform Policy:

Two uniforms will be provided free of charge. You are responsible for keeping them clean and laundered and then to return them on your last day of employment. You will be issued bathing suit, shorts (females) shirts, hat/visor. For days that may be cooler, you can wear black leggings under your uniform shorts and you can purchase a park issued sweatshirt at cost. Must wear sunglasses.

Description:

Footwear is only black sneakers, crocs or sandals with a heal strap. Must be freshly showered or bathed, use of deodorant is recommended. Neatly groomed facial hair is acceptable provided they are neat & grown in. No facial piercings, jewelry is limited to only wrist watches and wedding bands, two earrings, and necklaces that tuck under shirt. Ear gauges are not permitted. Tattoos cannot be on the face, hands, neck or be offensive. Hair color must be of a natural color.

Employer-owned or employer-arranged housing description:

The Bentley hotel has suite style rooms which accommodate 6 guests in total. There are 3 sets of bunk beds in a bedroom with a private bath, kitchenette, living room and either a patio (1st floor) or balcony (2nd floor). Provided items are: pool, air conditioning, bed linens, couch, coffee table, tv, refrigerator, microwave, and on site laundry (3 washing machines and 4 dryers). Splish Splash purchases and provides each room a multi pot cooker, utensils, and drinkware that should be returned in good condition at the end of the stay.

Weekly rent amount is due at the end of every week after the participant is paid. So either Friday or Saturday if they are not at work on Friday.

Deposit must be paid in cash upon arrival at the park on your first day to fill out paperwork. The weekly rent will be collected after you have received your first pay check, usually 10 - 14 days after you first arrive.

Deposit will be held until after the last day of your job offer agreement ends and your room has been inspected for damage. You will not receive your housing deposit back if you end your program or job early. Having a US bank account makes receiving your deposit and final check easy.

Deposit will be returned prior to your departure from the US as long as your last day of work is not in the same week as your flight.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Arrival Instructions:

- Here is the link for the Long Island Rail Road (LIRR for short!) It is to look up the train times from JFK airport to Riverhead for when you arrive. After you arrive in JFK airport you will take what is called the "Air Train" to the Jamaica Train Station. The air train fee is \$6, and it runs every 5 to 12 minutes daily. On this website you can look up times from the Jamaica train station to the Hampton bays train station. Hampton bays may not always have a continuous schedule. So please be sure to check times before you depart. http://lirr42.mta.info/
- From the Hampton Bays train station you will need to take an Uber or a taxi to the Bentley hotel. Keep in mind that the estimated travel time from the airport to the hotel can be anywhere between 3 6 hours depending on the time of day you arrive so please make sure you check train schedules ahead of time.

They can only be used before your punch in for your shift, during your breaks, and at the end of your shift when you punch out. You must notify your manager or supervisor at least 90 minutes prior to the start of your shift if you are not able to work a scheduled shift due to sickness.
