Employer-owned or employer-arranged housing description:

Living at Kings Canyon and Sequoia National Park is a special experience, the chance to reside among some of the most beautiful scenery in the world is a rare opportunity. For this opportunity, it may be necessary to sacrifice some of the privacy that some are used to and adjust to living in closer quarters than you may be accustomed to. Housing guidelines and rules have been formulated with the specific intent of enabling peaceful co-existence. The key to an enjoyable national park lifestyle is consideration and respect. We provide safe, friendly, comfortable, affordable shared housing. At Sequoia National Park we offer three types of housing, we assign rooms based upon availability: Lodepole – dormitory style – shared rooms with bunkbeds, up to 6 people in a room. Male and Female separate bathrooms, a common ty room and an outside Patio. On the second floor at Lodgepole market. Wuksachi – Cabins – shared room with one other

roommate. The central area is where there is a Male and Female Bathroom, the laundry area as well as the mail room. Wuksachi - Trailers – Two bedrooms with a full kitchen and a small bathroom. Can accommodate up to 4 roommates. Limited availability. Bedding (sheets and pillow) will be provided at no charge. Linen must be handed in at end of season or you will be charged for it from your final paycheck. You will be responsible for washing your own linen and cleaning your own bedroom, shared bathroom and all areas you utilize until the end of your utility agreement. Please understand that we do not supply residents with towels, toiletries, toilet paper or extra blankets so please make sure that you have these items until you have the time to visit a store. Weather in Sequoia National Park and Kings Canyon National Park can change quickly, regardless of the season. Even during the hottest months of the year, it gets surprisingly cool once the sun goes down. Pack clothing that you can layer, including a sweater or jacket for evenings and mornings, and comfortable shoes for walking and hiking. You may also want to bring a backpack to carry a water bottle, first aid kit, extra pair of socks, hat, etc.

As soon as you have booked your flight, train or bus ticket please confirm your arrival details with us. Arriving in the park, we like to meet you upon arrival, but if you arrive after hours we will make arrangements to pick your key up at the front desk. Our office hours are Monday thru Friday from 8am to 5pm.

If you arrive in Fresno or Visalia, we have a courier that can pick you up in town between 11am and 3pm on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. If you arrive at any other time, we will do our best to assist in arranging a ride for you, but you might need to book a hotel. During the summer months there is a park shuttle that that offers trips from Visalia and Three Rivers to Sequoia National Park.
