Job Description:

Step on up! As a game employee you are the life of the boardwalk! As a games attendant you will be working one of our classic boardwalk games attracting guests to your game and assuring they have an unforgettable experience while playing to win the grand prize.

Requirements:

A games employee will be in fast paced one on one communication and interaction with customers.

An employee must be able to project out to potential customers and attract attention to your game.

Basic math skills are required for currency exchanges

The employee must give an explanation and description of how each game is played.

Every employee will be responsible for maintaining and replenishing merchandise in midway games and they must maintain cleanliness of

the game area and merchandise prizes.

Physical Demands:

- An employee will occasionally be receiving incoming stock, Common Carrier, UPS, FEDEX unloading and distribution (20-25 LBS).
- Employees will be required to stand for long periods of time (6 8 hours).
- Specific vision abilities are required for this job and they include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus.
- Employees will be working indoors and outdoors and are exposed to all types of weather and, are also, exposed to loud noise throughout the day.

Typical Schedule:

We require that our employees are to be available to work a varied schedule. Employees must work weekends, nights and holiday shifts. A minimum of 35 hours weekly is required to work.

All work is weekend only until Memorial weekend and after Labor Day, during the season we are open full time and a minimum of 35 hours must be worked. Weekend, night and holiday shifts are required.

Game operators will be working outdoors, often in bright sun and will be exposed to hot, humid conditions, cold rainy temperatures, as well as fumes or airborne chemical particles. Employees are occasionally exposed to moving mechanical parts and vibration. The noise level is usually loud. All workers will perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, and stooping or bending. These activities also require considerable use of the arms and legs. Game operators will be required to stand for long periods of time. Will be required to lift, push, or carry objects weighing up to 25 pounds frequently and occasionally lift and/or move more than 100 pounds. Game operators may be moved between various games as needed.

Employer can provide housing for 2/3rds of the students but will find additional housing for remaining students that is similar in price and type. Company housing varies. We have houses, apartments, and rooms. Students can find their own housing, but must notify employer if they choose to do that. The housing cost is likely to be \$90 or higher, adjusted for shoulder seasons to accommodate fewer working hours.

Managers will go over details with students.

Casino Pier has a very strict no cell phone policy while working. All cellphones but be stored away properly prior to the start of their shift. Shifts are assigned by the scheduling manager and will be posted two weeks in advance online for employees to view. It is the responsibility of the employee to check their schedule and be on time for their shift. Any additional time off needed will need a request submitted with at least two weeks notice, time off requests are not guaranteed approvals. All employees are required to work a night shift, a weekend shift and all holiday shifts.

Seaside Heights has a noise ordinance that is strictly enforced during the summer, no large parties are allowed in housing, if there are any tickets/fines that are given, it is the responsibility of the tenant to pay.
