Housing will be on campus, just a short walk from the main area. Each unit is furnished with (2) twin beds and a walk in closet. Housing is cabins in a wooded area around other such units and costs \$15/night. There is a \$150.00 room deposit which is refundable at the end of the student's contract as long as the housing unit is in the same condition as when the student arrived and that no damage has occurred.
