Employment with Sun Valley can be a fun and rewarding experience if one comes with a balanced view. While most positions are routine and require commitment, ALL positions are important to the overall operation of the company and each one makes a valuable contribution to the guests' experience. More than 1,800 people are employed during the winter and 1,100 during summer peak periods.

Participants MUST:

- -Be willing to perform duties as assigned and accept changes in work schedule, and tasks as necessary.
- -Be aware that many positions are physically demanding and may require lifting, bending, standing, and kneeling.

Physical Demands:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand for long periods of time, walk, use hands, feel, reach with hands and arms, stoop, kneel, talk, hear, taste, and smell. The employee must have the ability to perform HEAVY WORK and repetitive motions.

Work Environment:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently exposed to various outside weather conditions. The employee is occasionally exposed to wet and/or humid conditions; slippery surfaces; moving mechanical parts; extreme cold and/or heat. Participants must also be able to work in an environment that is usually loud.

Work Hours:

Participants will receive an average of 32 hours per week over the course of their program. Scheduled workdays may fall on ANY day during the week (including national and state holidays).

NOTES ON HOUSING:

Housing is assigned by gender, job placements, and shifts. Dorm rooms are designed primarily for sleeping and storing a limited amount of personal items. Each dorm or floor has a common bathroom/shower area, which is used by all residents in that dorm wing. The dorms have several different styles of vending machines throughout the building including frozen foods (burritos, rice bowls, etc), fruits & vegetables, candy, and drinks. A coffee machine, ice machine, and microwaves will also be accessible outside of employee dining room operating hours.

key and stops when the dorm key is handed in.

Housing Deposit: The Housing Deposit is \$300.00 and should be paid before you arrive. An email from housing will be sent with directions on how to pay it before arrival. If there is damage to the housing and the cost of repairs exceeds the deposit amount, additional fees may be deducted from a participant's final paycheck. Rooms must be cleaned to receive a full deposit refund. All personal belongings must be removed, bedding must be handed in, the room must be vacuumed, and the sink must be washed. Please be aware that no pets are allowed in the dorms and babysitting is not permitted.

Linen: All bedding (sheets, blanket, pillow/pillowcase, and towels) will be provided at no charge. Linen must be handed in upon checking out of employee housing or participants may be charged from their final paycheck. Participants are responsible for washing their own linen during their stay until checking out.

PARTICIPANTS ARE ALLOWED TO MOVE IN THREE DAYS PRIOR TO DS2019 START DATE.

Benefits: Use of washers and dryers for free, cable hookup, phone line, and WiFi in rooms, a fully equipped gym, and communal television areas for residents to enjoy. Residents are also provided with cleaning supplies and vacuums when needed.

PLEASE NOTE: Participants are required to vacate the housing within up to 5 days of employment termination or ending employment early (quitting); please see the manager with any questions.

Participants will be meeting new people and interacting with Americans at work and on their time off. This area receives many tourists so participants will be able to interact with local Americans and visitors to this resort town on a daily basis. Experiencing American culture will be part of participants' lives while living in this seasonal area.
