Arrival Instructions:

There are two options for your travel to Houston, Texas. Employer suggests flying into George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) which offers more flight options and is typically more affordable for students.

1) George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH)

We recommend that students fly into George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) and take a Lyft or Uber to their new home in Houston. (approximate travel time 28 mins). The cost of a one-way Lyft or Uber will be about \$32.00 (up to 3 passengers, per vehicle). It's best to download the Lyft app or Uber app and request a ride. In case you are unable to download the app, here is the website Lyft www.lyft.com and Uber www.Uber.com Once you pick up your luggage, you will then request a ride. Lyft and Uber will only wait 5 minutes before leaving.

2) William P. Hobby (HOU)

Students also have the option to fly into William P. Hobby Airport (HOU). This airport has fewer international flights. Once you arrive, take a Lyft or Uber to your new home in Houston. (approximate travel time 25 mins). The cost of a one-way Lyft or Uber will be about \$22.00 (up to 3 passengers, per vehicle).
