Option 1:

Glacier Park International Airport (FCA): *this is a small airport and an overnight stay at a local hotel might be necessary. Flying directly to Glacier is best for students arriving from Europe.*

Plan to fly in on your scheduled arrival date (see job offer). Grouse Mountain Lodge staff are provided transport via hotel shuttle. Daytime arrival preferred. Please reach out to Alex Hopkins (ahopkins@pursuitcollection.com) and People & Culture (gpcpeople@pursuitcollection.com) to make a shuttle reservation.

Option 2:

Whitefish, MT Amtrak Station (WFH): (fly to Seattle, WA) and travel by overnight train to Whitefish, MT. This is an economical travel option and works best for students arriving from Asia. If traveling by train, plan to arrive one day before your work start date. Check out train tickets at www.amtrak.com.

Staff will report to the General Manager at Grouse Mountain Lodge for housing check-in prior to starting work. Orientation is held weekly. Shuttle assistance is necessary for transport from the airport or local hotel. Please send your full travel itinerary to the People & Culture Department (gpcpeople@pursuitcollection.com) at least two (2) weeks prior to your arrival.
