Swimming

Description:

Shallow Certification. With this Certification you will be able to guard all areas in the park. In order to acquire this certification, you must: Swim 50 yards continuously and in a comfortable fashion. Swim down 5.5 feet, retrieve a brick and swim it to the wall.

Lifting

Lifting requirement: 50lbs/22kgs

Description:

All workers will perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing and stooping or bending.

Description:

Lifeguards will be working outdoors, often in bright sun and will be exposed to hot, humid conditions, cold rainy temperatures, as well as fumes or airborne chemical particles. Employees are occasionally exposed to moving mechanical parts and vibration. The noise level is usually loud. All workers will perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, and stooping or bending. These activities also require considerable use of the arms and legs. Lifeguards will be required to stand for long periods of time and may be required to sit for extended periods of time on an elevated chair. Will be required to lift, push, or carry objects weighing up to 25 pounds frequently and occasionally lift and/or move more than 100 pounds. Lifeguards may be moved between various departments as needed.

Training requirements:

Advanced English, outgoing personality, ability to deal with public. Must meet minimum swimming requirements (swim 200 meters, pass CPR course and take written test) for lifeguarding certification classes. Complete any additional lifeguard training, as needed. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, ability to distinguish colors, an ability to adjust focus. Must have strong communication skills, a friendly, positive attitude and be dedicated to customer service. Must be able to work individually or in a team. Must be flexible and able to work where needed. Must have the ability to read and interpret

documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, procedural manuals. Must have the ability to write reports and correspondence in English. Must have ability to understand and respond to verbal instructions given in English. Must be able to go and retrieve objects in pool (10lbs/4.5Kg)

Arrival Instructions:

Students are expected to arrange their own travel to Seaside Heights and communicate their arrival time prior to traveling. Housing arrival times are between 10am - 9pm Monday - Friday. Arrivals after 9pm, and arrivals on Saturdays and Sundays will not be accepted.

Airport

It is most convenient for students to fly into Newark Airport (EWR). JFK Airport in New York is further away and you will experience more traffic and a higher cost of transportation to Seaside Heights.

Train or Bus

The NJ Transit bus can also be taken from Newark Penn Station (a short car/bus ride from Newark Airport). The bus is recommended because it will take you directly to the Toms River Bus Station which is only a 10 minute car/bus ride to Seaside Heights.

From Newark Airport there is an air shuttle available that will take travelers through each of the Newark Liberty Airport Terminals to the NJ Transit Train Station. Travelers can purchase a train ticket to "Point Pleasant Beach Station" for an estimated price of \$20.50. Once you arrive in Point Pleasant Beach, an Uber/Lyft car can take you to your assigned housing in Seaside Heights - this is about a 20 minute car drive.

TRAINING AND ONBOARDING

Grooming Requirements:

Must have neat and clean appearance at all times. Issued uniform shirts must be wrinkle and stain free and tucked into khaki pants or shorts. Nose and lip piercings must be removed or a clear stud must worn during working shifts. No extreme hair colors. No open-toed shoes or sandals allowed. Managers will go over details with employees.

We are in the business of fun, and want our employees to have fun while working! We will train you to be your best outgoing self while safely creating long-lasting memories not only for yourself, but for our guests too.

Casino Pier enforces a strict no cell phone policy while on duty. All cell phones must be securely stored away before your shift begins.

Shifts are assigned by the scheduling manager and will be posted two weeks in advance for employees to view. It is the employee's responsibility to check their schedule and arrive on time for their shift. Any requests for additional time off must be submitted at least two weeks in advance, and approval is not guaranteed. If management cannot accommodate a last-minute request, employees may be asked to find someone to cover their shift. All employees are required to work at least one night shift, one weekend shift, and all holiday shifts.

Smoking/vaping is not permitted on any of the Casino Pier & Breakwater Beach properties which also include housing. Employees must leave the property in order to smoke/vape.

Seaside Heights has a noise ordinance that is strictly enforced during the summer, no large parties are allowed in housing. If there are any tickets/fines that are given, it is the responsibility of the tenant(s) to pay.
