# Wildlife Sanctuary

Care for birds, mammals and reptiles in an animal sanctuary before they are released into the wild or kept within the sanctuary. You will assist the local staff in caring for animals of various species, including jaguars, macaws, tapirs, sloths and anteaters. These animals will later be released into the wild if possible.

### Turtle and Marine Conservation

Assist with the conservation and protection of up to four of the seven different species of sea turtle. These include loggerhead turtle, hawksbill turtle and green turtle, but especially leatherback turtle. You will assist the biologist in residence in caring for injured animals, moving eggs to safe hatcheries, and collecting and processing biometric data.

# Physical Education Training

Teach Physical Education in one of the schools around Esparza and get an inside track on the Costa Rican educational system. This is a chance to step up to a challenge well suited to your skill level. Since many of the schools have no formal sports equipment, regimen, or sports hall, you'll have a chance to be creative in your use of the space outdoors for training.

Assist the resident biologist and the rest of the team with the conservation and protection of up to four of the seven unique species of sea turtles. During your time at the project, you will assist the resident biologist in caring for injured animals, moving eggs to safe hatcheries, and collecting and processing biometric data.
